

Outline of the Life of Saint Francis and Saint Clare of Assisi

(Put the 12 squares included in your packet in order by date)

- 1. 1181 (or 1182) Francis is born in Assisi
- 2. 1193 (or 1194) Clare is born in Assisi
- 3. 1205 Francis hears God's voice while praying before the cross of San Damiano
- 4. 1206-1208 Francis works at a local monastery. He cares for people with illnesses and repairs the local churches.
- 5. February 24, 1208 Francis sews a rough robe for himself and begins preaching barefoot in the streets.
- 6. 1208 Francis lives at Portiuncula and other young men join him. They go out to preach in many towns.
- 7. 1211 (or 1212) On Palm Sunday, Clare joins Francis and begins the order of the Poor Clares
- 8. May 5, 1217 The friars in Portiuncula decide new missions.
- 9. 1219-1220 Francis sails for the East with the Crusaders. In Egypt, he meets the Sultan.
- 10. December 24, 1223 In Greccio, Francis creates the first live nativity scene.
- 11. August 15, 1224 Francis receives the stigmata, the signs of Christ's suffering.
- 12. 1224-1225 Francis spends the winter in the monastery where Clare lives. He composes the "Canticle of the Sun."

October 3, 1226 Francis dies. August 11, 1253 Clare dies.
