

Prayers to Know for youth in Grade 6

2. **The Hail Mary, Grace Before Meals, Our Father, and Glory Be.**
3. **An Act of Contrition**
4. **The Rosary, including the Mysteries of the Rosary and the Hail Holy Queen.**
5. **The Apostle's Creed**
6. The Nicene Creed
7. Prayer based on scripture or the writings of the Saints, and be familiar with other types of prayers.
