  - +To play, call one Saint at a time. Read the summary of the Saint from the Information sheet +Have the players cover the picture that you called. If they get 5 in a row (horizontal, vertical, or diagonal), they yell BINGO.
- 4. **A pamphlet on Living a Merciful Life** Parents, please read the pamphlet and discuss the role of Mercy with your children.
- 5. **An easy recipe for Bread**. Make the bread with your children, then bless and share the bread as a family. The traditional blessing is:
