



## ILLNESS FLOW CHART

### COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

- Fever (T >100.4°F or 38°C) or chills
- New cough
- New shortness of breath or hypoxia
- Muscle aches
- New headache
- New URI symptoms (rhinorrhea (running nose), nasal congestion, sore throat)
- New loss of sense of smell or taste
- New diarrhea
- New rash

My child develops a symptom of COVID-19.

One Symptom (non-fever): students may return 24 hours from symptom resolution or a negative COVID test result.

**Fever, cough, shortness of breath encouraging a COVID test.**

If two or more symptoms (or just a fever) are present, students and staff can return to school with a negative Covid-19 test result or a note from a healthcare provider that there is most likely an alternative diagnosis.  
**Siblings can remain in school as long as symptom free and with approval of administration.**

Students and staff with confirmed case of COVID-19 will only return to school after they are no longer infectious which will be determined by the Washtenaw County Health Department Guidelines.

At that time siblings will need to quarantine.

Following a negative Covid-19 test, students can return to school 24 hours from symptom resolution.

Students will also be EXCLUDED from school:

- If they have had close contact or potential exposure risk in the past 14 days: Quarantine for 14 days.
- Travelled internationally: Quarantine for 14 days.
- If a family member gets sick, a family should quarantine from 24 hours after last symptom. If I get sick then it clears in 13 days, my families' 14 day quarantine starts after my symptom resolution depending on how much "close contact" they receive.
