The Mass is a celebration to give thanks to God. Mass is the great thanksgiving prayer of the people of God. The word Eucharist means "thank you."

In Mass: 1) We come together as members of the one family of God. 2) We listen to God's Word in the Bible. We answer in song, prayer, and the creed (the words of our beliefs). 3) In the Eucharist, we share the special meal that Jesus gave us, when he gave us the gift of himself. This meal is also a sacrifice where we remember Jesus' dying and rising to new life. 4) We are sent out to the world to love and serve the Lord. We do this by loving and helping others.

+ What are the gifts that we offer at Mass?

Bread and wine. We also give food and money for the needs of the poor and the work of the Church. We offer ourselves to God.

+ How is Communion different than ordinary bread and wine?

The bread and wine given as gifts in Mass are changed to the Body and Blood of Jesus. In receiving Jesus in Holy Communion, we share in the very Life and Love of God.
